Rules For the Day

- 1. All competitors ride at their own risk
- 2. Horses/ponies must compete in one ring only.
- 3. Snaffle bridles to be used in all rings with the exception of the Open Ring. Other bits may be used with judges permission.
- 4. NZPCA qualified hats/helmets must be worn in all events.
- 5. The Judge's decision is FINAL.
- 6. Judges can adjust the programme if need be.
- 7. Entry fees are non-refundable.
- 8. Waiuku Pony Club takes no responsibility for damage or injury to personal property, motor vehicles etc.
- 9. NO DOGS ALLOWED
- 10. Horses/ponies that kick must have a red ribbon attached to their tail.
- 11. All complaints to be made to Secretary or President on the day.
- 12. Bad language, excess use of whips/spurs or cruelty to horse/pony will not be tolerated and anyone breaching this will be asked to leave the grounds.

Points to Note:-

- A Novice Rider is one who has not won more than 3 rider classes at an Open Ribbon Day, Gymkhana or A & P Show.
- Novice Pony/Hack is one who has not won a maiden/novice event at any Open Ribbon Day, Gymkhana or A & P Show.
- Riders on Lead Rein must remain on lead for the duration of all classes, unless permission is granted by the judge to change.
- Permission may be sought for an Open rider to compete in the Novice ring for the jumping part of the day. Please contact the secretary.
- The committee/judges reserve the right to redirect a rider to the appropriate ring.
- Classes may be split or combined at the judge's discretion if numbers warrant.
- The Consolation Event is for non-ribbon winners only.
- Please direct any complaints to the Club Rooms. Please do not enter rings or confront judges or stewards.
- Show good manners and sportsmanship please.


